ORDER

Sub: Diversion of 0.378 ha of Revenue forest land for construction of 400 KV Talcher-Meramundali D/C Transmission Line of PGCIL at village Kamalanga in Dhenkanal District, Odisha.

WHEREAS, the Power Grid Corporation of India Limited (PGCIL), Kanhia, Dist-Angul, Head Office at Plot No.4, Unit-41, Niladri Vihar, Chandrasekharapur, Bhubaneswar had applied for diversion of 0.378 ha of Revenue forest land for construction of 400 KV Talcher-Meramundali D/C Transmission Line at village Kamalanga in Dhenkanal District, Odisha.

And whereas, the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change (hereinafter referred to as MoEF&CC), Government of India, Eastern Regional Office, Bhubaneswar had accorded 'Stage-I/in-principle' approval for diversion of 0.378 ha of Revenue forest land for construction of 400 KV Talcher-Meramundali D/C Transmission Line of PGCIL at village Kamalanga in Dhenkanal District, Odisha vide its letter No.5-ORB403/2019-BHU dtd.16.01.2020 (**Annexure-I**).

And whereas, the MoEF&CC, Government of India, Integrated Regional Office, Bhubaneswar in consideration of the compliance of the conditions of the 'in-principle' approval, has accorded Stage-II/ final approval under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.378 ha of Revenue forest land for construction of 400 KV Talcher-Meramundali D/C Transmission Line of PGCIL at village Kamalanga in Dhenkanal District, Odisha vide its letter No.5-ORB403/2019-BHU dtd.09.02.2021 (**Annexure-II**) subject to fulfillment of conditions as stipulated therein in Para-A & B.

Now therefore, the Government of Odisha, do hereby allow diversion of above mentioned 0.378 ha. of revenue forest land in favour of user agency as per approved land use pattern subject to fulfillment of the conditions of final forest clearance order as stipulated by the MoEF&CC, Government of India, Integrated Regional Office, Bhubaneswar. The details land schedule of forest land as received from PCCF, Odisha along with diversion proposal vide his letter No.21604 dtd.07.12.2019 are appended herewith as **Annexure-III (Two Pages)**.

The Collector, Dhenkanal and Divisional Forest Officer, Dhenkanal Forest Division are hereby authorized to handover the revenue forest land coming within their jurisdiction, after compliance of **condition-A i.e. Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land**, as has been finally diverted following due procedure of law. Before handing over the forest land to the user agency, it shall be ensured that Net Present Value of forest land for this project as well as for any other projects, belonging to same user agency, is deposited, in full, at

applicable rates. Condition as laid down in condition-B i.e. Conditions which need to be complied after handing over of forest land to the user agency as stipulated in the final approval order dtd.09.02.2021 should also be complied.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Dhenkanal Forest Division is also directed to monitor compliance to the conditions stipulated for such diversion in the respective forest/Wildlife clearance order and to report violations, if any, to the Nodal Officer, O/o PCCF, Odisha and to the Forest & Environment Department.

Execution of project activities will be subject to availability of all other statutory clearances required under relevant Acts/Rules for this project, deposit of requisite funds and compliance of Court's order, if any.





The User Agency may also be instructed to furnish compliance to the conditions of forest/ wildlife clearance pertaining to the project in every quarter to the Divisional Forest Officer concerned for facilitating monitoring of compliances by them.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Dhenkanal Forest Division is also instructed to ensure that the direction given to the user agency are executed immediately.



The user agency is asked to take following actions immediately as per orders of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal dtd.07.11.2012 in Appeal No.7/2012 communicated by the MoEF, Government of India vide their letter F. No.7-23/2012-FC dtd.24.07.2013.

- i. *They shall publish the entire forest clearance granted in verbatim along with conditions and safeguards imposed by the Central Government in Stage-I/II forest clearance in two widely circulated daily newspapers, one in vernacular language and the other in English language so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the Project for use of forest land for non-forest purposes.*
- ii. *They shall submit the copies of forest clearance orders granted by the Central Government/State Government to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies in addition to the relevant offices of the Government, who in turn, has to display the same for 30 days from date of receipt.*
- iii. *Detailed action taken in compliance to the above order of State Government shall be intimated to the Divisional Forest Officer, Dhenkanal Forest Division / Regional Chief Conservator of Forests, Angul Circle / Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Odisha / Forest & Environment Department for reference.*

Besides the above, the user agency is also asked to deposit Net Present Value of forest land for this project and for any other projects belonging to him in full, if

not deposited yet, at applicable rates. Also requisite funds due for deposit by the user agency on account of this project shall also be deposited in State CAMPA Account.

The user agency shall furnish compliances to the conditions prescribed in the forest/wildlife clearance order to the Divisional Forest Officer, Dhenkanal Forest Division in every quarter, for the purpose of monitoring by him.

Diversion of 0.378 ha of Revenue forest land for construction of 400 KV Talcher-Meramundali D/C Transmission Line of PGCIL at village Kamalanga in Dhenkanal District, Odisha.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Govt. letter No10F(Cons)121/19-25364/F&E dated 24.12.2019 on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

2. After due consideration of the proposal of the State Government, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change hereby conveys 'Stage-I/in-principle' approval for diversion of 0.378 ha of Revenue forest land for construction of 400 KV Talcher-Meramundali D/C Transmission Line of PGCIL at village Kamalanga in Dhenkanal District, Odisha, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions.

- i) Legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged.
- ii) Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the user agency.
- iii) The State Govt. shall realize the cost of plantation (including 10 years maintenance) of ten times the number of trees likely to be felled (subject to a minimum no. of 100 plants) from the user agency towards compensatory afforestation.
- iv) The State Govt. shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for 0.378 ha forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the user agency as per the Orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30.10.2002, 01.08.2003, 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in IA No.566 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by Ministry vide letter No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II) dated 18.09.2003, as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC dated 03.10.2006 and No.5-3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009 in this regard.
- v) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Govt. from the user agency. The user agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- vi) All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to State CAMPA fund only through (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>).
- vii) The user agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the user agency with the State Forest Department.


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- viii) The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector. The FRA certificate in Form-II (for linear projects other than Plantation) shall be submitted before Stage-II approval.
- ix) The user agency in consultation with the State Forest Department shall prepare a detailed scheme for creation and maintenance of plantation of dwarf species (preferably medicinal species) in right of way under the transmission line, and provide funds for execution of the said scheme by the State Forest Department.
- x) The user agency at its cost shall provide bird deflectors, which are to be fixed on upper conductor of transmission line at suitable intervals to avoid bird hits.
- xi) The user agency shall comply with the guidelines for laying transmission lines through forest areas issued by Ministry vide letter No.7-25/2012-FC dated 05.05.2014 and 19.11.2014.
- xii) The user agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of Environment (Protection) Act, 1980, if applicable.
- xiii) The layout plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without the prior approval of Central Government.
- xiv) No labour camp shall be allowed in the forest area.
- xv) Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the user agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- xvi) The user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.
- xvii) The boundary of the forest land to be diverted shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- xviii) No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work.
- xix) The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease granted in favour of user agency or the project life, whichever is less.
- xx) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
- xxi) The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without the prior approval of Government of India.
- xxii) The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all the Court orders, provisions, rules, regulations and guidelines for the time being in force as applicable to the project.




xxiii) Any other conditions that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency.

xxiv) The compliance report of the Stage-I approval shall be uploaded on e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in>).

3. After receipt of the report on compliance to the conditions stipulated above, from the State Government of Odisha, final/Stage-II approval for diversion of the said forest land under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 will be issued by this Ministry. Transfer of forest land to user agency should not be effected by the State Government of Odisha till final/Stage-II approval for its diversion is issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.

4. However, to facilitate speedy execution of projects involving linear diversion, the in-principle approval may be deemed as the working permission for tree felling and commencement of work, if the required funds for CA, NPV and all other compensatory levies specified in the in-principle approval are realized from the user agency, the State Govt. may allow the commencement of work of the linear project in forest land for a period of one year as per Para 11.2 of Chapter-11 of Handbook of Guidelines issued under F.C. Act, 1980 vide Ministry's letter No.5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.

Sub:- Diversion of 0.378 ha of Revenue forest land for construction of 400 KV Talcher-Meramundali D/C Transmission Line of PGCIL at village Kamalanga in Dhenkanal District, Odisha.

Madam,

I am directed to refer to State Govt. letter No.10F(Cons)121/19-25364/F&E dated 24.12.2019 , wherein prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change for diversion 0.378 ha of Revenue forest land for construction of 400 KV Talcher-Meramundali D/C Transmission Line of PGCIL at village Kamalanga in Dhenkanal District, Odisha, was sought in accordance with Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. After due consideration of the proposal by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, the in-principle approval for diversion of the said forest land was accorded by Ministry vide this office letter of even number dated 16.01.2020, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions. The Nodal Officer (FCA) of the State Government has furnished the compliance report in respect of the conditions stipulated in the in-principle approval and has requested to grant final approval of the proposal.

2. In this connection, I am directed to say that on the basis of the compliance report furnished by the PCCF & Nodal Officer (FCA), Odisha vide their letter No.1183/9F (ET)-378/2019 dated 20.01.2021 and uploading of the Stage-I compliance report in Parivesh web portal on 27.01.2021, **Stage-II/final** approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change is hereby granted under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 0.378 ha of Revenue forest land for construction of 400 KV Talcher-Meramundali D/C Transmission Line of PGCIL at village Kamalanga in Dhenkanal District, Odisha, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

- A: Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land.**
- The State Govt. shall ensure the complete compliance on FRA, 2006.
 - The State Govt. shall ensure that forest land will be handed over only after required

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- non-forest land for the project is handed over to the user agency.
- iii. The State Govt. shall ensure that the user agency shall obtain the Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if required.
 - iv. The State Govt. shall ensure that the boundary of the diverted forest land shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates.

B: Conditions which need to be complied after handing over of forest land to the user agency.

- i. Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.
- ii. The State Govt. shall ensure that the State Forest Department shall carry out plantation of 1500 trees towards compensatory afforestation within three years from the issue of approval as per approved plan/scheme and maintained thereafter, from the funds deposited by the user agency in CAMPA account. The trees shall be indigenous to the area and naturally growing species shall be planted using intensive planting technique to ensure survival of the plantation. Documentation of plantation area shall be done with geo tag images so as to monitor and evaluate the survival and growth of plantation over the years. A six monthly report of the afforestation status shall be submitted to this office for record and monitoring.
- iii. The State Govt. shall ensure that the State Forest Department shall carry out plantation of dwarf species (preferably medicinal species) in right of way under the transmission line, within three years from the issue of approval as per approved plan/scheme and maintained thereafter, from the funds deposited by the user agency in CAMPA account. Documentation of plantation area shall be done with geo tag images so as to monitor and evaluate the survival and growth of plantation over the years. A six monthly report of the afforestation status shall be submitted to this office for record and monitoring.
- iv. The user agency shall pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
- v. The State Govt. shall ensure that the user agency at its cost shall provide bird deflectors, which are to be fixed on upper conductor of transmission line at suitable intervals to avoid bird hits.
- vi. The State Govt. shall ensure that the user agency shall comply with the guidelines for laying transmission lines through forest areas issued by Ministry vide letter No.7-25/2012-FC dated 05.05.2014 and 19.11.2014.
- vii. The State Govt. and the user agency shall ensure that the period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease granted in favour of user agency or the project life, whichever is less.
- viii. The State Govt. shall ensure that no labour camp shall be established on the forest land and the user agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.
- ix. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that while executing works, the user agency shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.
- x. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that no additional or new path will be

- constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work.
- xi. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that earth or any material shall neither be brought from nor the debris resulting during construction be disposed of in the adjoining forest area by the user agency.
- xii. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that the layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.
- xiii. The State Govt. shall ensure that the forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal and under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.
- xiv. The State Govt. shall ensure that the user agency shall explore the possibility of successful translocation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.
- xv. The State Govt. shall ensure that the user agency shall submit annual self monitoring report on compliance of stipulated conditions to the Nodal Officer (FCA) of the State and Integrated Regional Office of this Ministry by the end of March every year regularly.
- xvi. The State Govt. shall ensure that any other conditions that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, which shall be complied by the user agency.
- xvii. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT Order (s) & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
- xviii. It may please note that violation of any of these conditions will be amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per Para 1.21 of Chapter-1 of Handbook of Guidelines issued under F.C. Act, 1980 vide Ministry's letter No.5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.
