#### ORDER

Sub: Diversion of 10.58 ha of Revenue forest land of Sijua village under Bhubaneswar Tahasil of Khurda District under City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar for construction of Centres of Excellence namely Cardio-thorasic & Vascular Surgery (CTVS), Oncology, Neuroscience, Nephrology by AIIMS.

WHEREAS, the Professor & HOD, Radiotherapy, All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), Bhubaneswar had applied for diversion of 10.58 ha of Revenue forest land of Sijua village under Bhubaneswar Tahasil of Khurda District under City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar for construction of Centres of Excellence namely Cardio-thorasic & Vascular Surgery (CTVS), Oncology, Neuroscience, Nephrology.

And whereas, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India, IRO, Bhubaneswar had accorded 'Stage-I/in-principle' approval for diversion of 10.58 ha of Revenue forest land of Sijua village under Bhubaneswar Tahasil of Khurda District under City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar for construction of Centres of Excellence namely Cardio-thorasic & Vascular Surgery (CTVS), Oncology, Neuroscience, Nephrology by AIIMS, subject to fulfilment of certain conditions vide its letter No.5-ORC439/2020-BHU dtd.07.01.2021 (Annexure-I).

And whereas, the MoEF&CC, Government of India, IRO, Bhubaneswar in consideration of the compliance of the conditions of the 'Stage-I/in-principle' approval, have accorded Stage-II/final approval under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 10.58 ha of Revenue forest land of Sijua village under Bhubaneswar Tahasil of Khurda District under City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar for construction of Centres of Excellence namely Cardio-thorasic & Vascular Surgery (CTVS), Oncology, Neuroscience, Nephrology by AIIMS vide its letter No.5-ORC439/2020-BHU dtd.30.12.2021 (Annexure-II) subject to conditions as stipulated therein.

Now therefore, the Government of Odisha, do hereby allow diversion of 10.58 ha of Revenue forest land of Sijua village under Bhubaneswar Tahasil of Khurda District under City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar for construction of Centres of Excellence namely Cardio-thorasic & Vascular Surgery (CTVS), Oncology, Neuroscience, Nephrology by AIIMS, as per approved land schedule (Certificate from Tahasildar, Bhubaneswar) furnished by PCCF & HoFF, Odisha vide their letter No.19170 dtd.04.10.2020 subject to fulfilment of the conditions of final forest

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clearance order as stipulated by the MoEF&CC, Government of India, IRO, Bhubaneswar. The land schedule (Certificate from Tahasildar, Bhubaneswar) of forest land as received from PCCF & HoFF, Odisha vide their letter No.19170 dtd.04.10.2020 are appended herewith as **Annexure-III (1 Page)**.

The Collector, Khurda and Divisional Forest Officer, City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar, as the case may be are hereby authorized to handover the forest land coming within their jurisdiction, after necessary compliance as has been finally diverted following due procedure of law. Before handing over the diverted forest land to the user agency, it shall be ensured that Net Present Value of the forest land for this project for which approval has been obtained shall be deposited in full, at applicable rates.

The Divisional Forest Officer, City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar is also directed to monitor compliance to the conditions stipulated for such diversion in the respective forest/wildlife clearance order and to report violations, if any, to the Nodal Officer, O/o Principal Chief Conservator Forests & HoFF, Odisha and to the Forest, Environment & Climate Change Department.

Execution of project activities will be subject to availability of all other statutory clearances required under relevant Acts/Rules for this project, deposit of requisite funds and compliance of Court's order, if any.

The user agency is asked to take following actions immediately as per orders of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal dtd.07.11.2012 in Appeal No.07/2012 communicated by the MoEF, Government of India vide their letter F. No.7-23/2012-FC dtd.24.07.2013.

i. They shall publish the entire forest clearance granted in verbatim along with conditions and safeguards imposed by the Central Government in Stage-I/II forest clearance in two widely circulated daily newspapers, one in vernacular language and the other in English language so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the Project for use of forest land for non-forest purposes.

ii. They shall submit the copies of forest clearance orders granted by the Central Government/State Government to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies along with the relevant offices of the State Government, who in turn, shall

display the same for 30 days from date of receipt.

iii. Detailed action taken in compliance to the above order of State Government shall be intimated to the DFO, City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar / RCCF, Bhubaneswar Circle / PCCF & HoFF, Odisha /Forest, Environment & Climate Change Department for reference.

Besides the above, the user agency is also asked to deposit Net Present Value of forest land for this project in full, if not deposited yet, at applicable rates. Requisite funds due for deposit by the user agency on account of this project shall also be deposited under appropriate head.

The user agency shall furnish compliances to the conditions prescribed in the forest/wildlife clearance order to the Divisional Forest Officer, City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar in every quarter, for the purpose of monitoring by him.

He is requested to upload this order along with its enclosures in the website of Forest, Environment & Climate Change Department immediately for information of all concerned. 

Diversion of 10.58 ha of Revenue forest land of Sijua village under Bhubaneswar Tahasil of Khurda District under City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar for construction of Centres of Excellence namely Cardio-thorasic & Vascular Surgery (CTVS), Oncology, Neuroscience, Nephrology by AIIMS.

Madam,

I am directedto refer to State Govt. letter No10F(Cons)172/2020-19032/F&E dated 26.11.2020 on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

2. After due consideration of the proposal of the State Government and on the basis of decision of Regional Empowered Committee meeting held on 28.12.2020, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change hereby conveys 'Stage-L'in-principle' approval for diversion of 10.58 ha of Revenue forest land of Sijua village under Bhubaneswar Tahasil of Khurda District under City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar for construction of Centres of Excellence namely Cardio-thorasic & Vascular Surgery (CTVS), Oncology, Neuroscience, Nephrology by AIIMS, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions.

Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.

i. The user agency shall transfer online, the Net Present Value (NPV) of 10.58 ha forest land being diverted under this proposal, as per the Orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in Writ Petition (Civil)

- No.202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide its letter No.5-3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009. The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal in CAMPA account of the State concerned.
- ii. The identified non-forest land of 10.58 ha for raising compensatory afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in the name of Forest Department and notified as RF/PF prior to Stage-II approval.
- iii. The land identified for the purpose of Compensatory Afforestation shall be clearly depicted on a Survey of India Topo sheet of 1:50,000 scale.
- iv. The user agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation at the current wage rate in consultation with State Forest Department in the account of CAMPA of the concerned State through online portal. The Scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.
- v. All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited in CAMPA account only through e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/). Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the Stage-I clearance.
- vi. The cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the user agency with the State Forest Department.
- vii.The compliance report of the Stage-I approval shall be uploaded on e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/).
- viii. The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.
- ix. The boundary of the proposed forest land for diversion, shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates.
- x. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in Para 1.21 of Chapter 1 of the Handbook of comprehensive guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter No.5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.
- B: Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the user agency by the State Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval.
  - i. Legal status of forest land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged.
  - ii. Compensatory afforestation shall be raised over 10.58 ha non-forest land identified in village Badasireipur-Dorabad under Banapur Tahasil under Khurda Forest Division within three years from the date of Stage-II Clearance and maintained thereafter by the State Forest Department at the cost of user agency and at least 1000 plants per hectare shall be planted over identified non-forest land within three years of grant of final approval. If it is not possible to plant so many saplings in the area identified for C.A., the balance saplings will be planted in any other forests as per prescription of approved working plan with provision for ten years on subsequent maintenance.
  - iii. At the time of payment of Net Present Value (NPV) at the then prevailing rate, the user agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
  - iv. The user agency shall limit the construction of buildings over 6.28 ha of forest land and increase for Greenery activities from 1.28 ha to 2.28 ha of forest land.

v. The user agency shall obtain Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.

vi. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land and the user agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.

vii. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work.

viii. The user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.

ix. The layout plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.

x. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.

xi. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.

xii. No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused.

xiii. The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area.

xiv. The user agency shall explore the possibility of successful translocation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.

xv. The period of diversion under this approval shall be co-terminus with the period of lease granted in favour of user agency or the project life, whichever is less.

xvi. The user agency shall submit annual self monitoring report on compliance of stipulated conditions to the Nodal Officer (FCA) of the State and concerned Integrated Regional Office of this Ministry by the end of March every year..

xvii. Any other conditions that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency.

Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT Order (s) & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.

3. After receipt of the report on compliance to the conditions stipulated above, from the State Government of Odisha, final/Stage-II approval for diversion of the said forest land under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 will be issued by this Ministry. Transfer of forest land to user agency should not be effected by the State Government of Odisha till final/Stage-II approval for its diversion is issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.

Madam,

I am directed to refer to State Govt. letter No.10F(Cons)172/2020-19032/F&E dated 26.11.2020, wherein prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change for diversion of 10.58 ha of Revenue forest land of Sijua village under Bhubaneswar Tahasil of Khurda District under City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar for construction of Centres of Excellence namely Cardio-thorasic & Vascular Surgery (CTVS), Oncology, Neuroscience, Nephrology by AIIMS, was sought in accordance with Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. After due consideration of the proposal by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change and on the basis of decision of Regional Empowered Committee meeting held on 28.12.2020, the in-principle approval for diversion of the said forest land was accorded by Ministry vide this office letter of even number dated 07.01.2021, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions. The Nodal Officer (FCA) of the State Government has furnished the compliance report in respect of the conditions stipulated in the in-principle approval and has requested to grant final approval of the proposal.

2. In this connection, I am directed to say that on the basis of the compliance report furnished by the CF & Nodal Officer (FCA), Odisha vide their letter No.20542/9F (Misc.)-370/2020 dated 01.12.2021, Stage-II/final approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change is hereby granted under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 10.58 ha of Revenue forest land of Sijua village under Bhubaneswar Tahasil of Khurda District under City Forest Division, Bhubaneswar for construction of Centres of Excellence namely Cardio-thorasic & Vascular Surgery (CTVS), Oncology, Neuroscience, Nephrology by AIIMS, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

A: Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land.

- i. The State Govt. shall ensure the complete compliance on FRA, 2006.
- ii. The State Govt. shall ensure that forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for project is handed over by the user agency.

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iii. The State Govt. shall ensure that the user agency shall obtain the Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if required.

iv. The State Govt. shall ensure that the KML files of the area to be diverted and the CA areas shall be uploaded on the e-Green watch portal with all requisite details before

handing over of the diverted forest land to the user agency.

v. The State Govt. shall ensure that the boundary of the diverted forest land shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates.

### Conditions which need to be complied after handing over of forest land to the user agency.

i. Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.

- ii. The State Govt. shall ensure that the State Forest Department will raise the Compensatory afforestation over 10.58 ha non-forest land identified in village Badasireipur-Dorabad under Banapur Tahasil under Khurda Forest Division district within three years from the date of Stage-II Clearance and maintained thereafter by the State Forest Department from the funds deposited by the user agency in CAMPA account. The species to be planted in the CA scheme shall be of native species of the area avoiding Teak and exotic species. At least 18 month old seedlings should be planted. Intensive monitoring of the plantation needs to be done and documented using Geo tagging so that the increase of canopy density and survival and growth of plantation can be evaluated at regular intervals.
- iii. The State Govt. shall ensure that the user agency shall pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of
- iv. The State Govt. and the user agency shall ensure that limit the construction of buildings over 6.28 ha of forest land and increase for Greenery activities from 1.28 ha to 2.28 ha of forest land.
- v. The State Govt. shall ensure that no labour camp shall be established on the forest land and the user agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest
- vi. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that no additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work.
- vii. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that while executing works, the user agency shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in
- viii. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that the layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.
- ix. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that earth or any material shall neither be brought from nor the debris resulting during construction be disposed of in the adjoining forest area by the user agency.
- x. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that no damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused.
- xi. The State Govt. shall ensure that the user agency shall explore the possibility of successful transplantation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and

shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.

xii. The State Govt. shall ensure that the forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal and under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.

xiii. The State Govt. shall ensure that the DFO concerned will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in

surrounding area.

xiv. The State Govt. shall ensure that the user agency shall submit annual self monitoring report on compliance of stipulated conditions to the Nodal Officer (FCA) of the State and Integrated Regional Office of this Ministry by the end of March every year regularly.

xv. The State Govt. shall ensure that any other conditions that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, which

shall be complied by the user agency.

xvi. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT Order (s) & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.

xvii.It may please be noted that violation of any of these conditions will be amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per Para 1.21 of Chapter-1 of Handbook of Guidelines issued under F.C. Act, 1980 vide Ministry's letter No.5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.


