Sub: Diversion of 12.63 ha. of forest land for laying of slurry pipeline for disposal of ash from Captive Power Plant(CPP) of National Aluminium Company Ltd.(NALCO) to Bharatpur South Coal of Mahanadi Coalfields ltd. and to bring back decanted water from the mines after treatment to CPP for re-use in Angul district, Odisha.

WHEREAS, the General Manager, Captive Power Plant, National Aluminum Company Limited, Angul, Pin 759122 had applied for diversion of 12.63 ha. of forest land for laying of slurry pipeline for disposal of ash from their Captive Power Plant(CPP) to Bharatpur South Coal of Mahanadi Coalfields ltd. and to bring back decanted water from the mines after treatment to CPP for re-use in Angul district, Odisha.

And whereas, the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change (hereinafter referred to as MoEF&CC), Government of India, Eastern Regional Office had accorded 'in-principle' approval for diversion of 12.63ha. of forest land for laying of slurry pipeline for disposal of ash from Captive Power Plant(CPP) of National Aluminium Company Ltd.(NALCO) to Bharatpur South Coal of Mahanadi Coalfields ltd. and to bring back decanted water from the mines after treatment to CPP for re-use in Angul district, Odisha vide its letter No. 5-ORC201/2014 dt. 05.09.2014 (ANNEXURE-1).

And whereas, the MoEF&CC, Government of India, Eastern Regional office in consideration of the compliance of the conditions of the 'in-principle' approval, has accorded final approval for diversion of the said 12.63ha. of forest land in favour of above mentioned applicant agency vide its letter No. 5-ORC201/2014 dt. 07.02.2017 under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980; MoEF&CC, GoI, ERO vide their letter No. 5-ORC201/2014-BHU dt. 28.6.2017 had modified condition No. 2(iv) of their earlier final forest clearance order dt. 7.2.2017 with regard to no. of plants required to be planted/maintained pertaining to the above diversion proposal. Copy of letter No. 5-ORC201/2014 dt. 07.02.2017/28.6.2017 are enclosed herewith as Annexure-2.

As per modified condition, 7,800 no. of plants are required to be planted over the earlier identified degraded forest land or the fresh degraded forest land to be identified. Accordingly the Addl. PCCF(Forest Diversion) & Nodal Officer, FC Act has approved the additional CA scheme over 13.458ha. of degraded forest land identified in Balibo RF of Bhuban Range under Dhenkanal Forest Division for planting the balance 7,800 no. of plants at an approved cost of Rs. 12,20,700/- that also includes cost of maintenance of 10 years.

Now therefore considering the importance of this infrastructure project, the Government of Odisha do hereby allow diversion of forest land of 12.63ha. in Angul district in favour of M/s National Aluminum Company Limited, as per approved land use pattern(land schedule duly authenticated by Divisional Forest Officer, Angul Division as received from PCCF, Odisha vide his letter No. 4328 dt. 4.3.2014 appended herewith as Annexure-3), subject to fulfillment of the conditions stipulated by the MoEF&CC, Government of India, Eastern Regional Office with specific reference to payment of approved cost of additional CA scheme amounting to Rs. 12,20,700/- by the user agency through e-payment in Adhoc-CAMPA Account.

The Collector, Angul and Divisional Forest Officer, Angul Forest Division are authorized to handover the forest land, as has been diverted, within their jurisdiction, to the user agency following due procedure of law. Before handing over the forest land to the user agency, it shall be ensured that approved cost of additional CA scheme amounting to Rs. 12,20,700/- is deposited by the user agency through e-payment in Adhoc-CAMPA as per demand raised in this context by the DFO, Dhenkanal. Besides, it shall also be ensured that Net Present Value for forest land for this project as well as for any other projects, belonging to same user agency, is also deposited, in full, at applicable rates.

The Divisional Forest Officer of Angul Division is also directed to monitor compliance to the conditions stipulated for such diversion in the respective forest/ Wildlife clearance order and to report violations, if any, to the Nodal Officer, O/O Pr. CCF, Odisha and to the Forest & Environment Department.

Execution of project activities will be subject to having all other statutory clearances required under relevant Act/Rules for this mining project, deposit of requisite funds and compliance of Court's order, if any.

I am directed to refer to State Govt. letter No.10F(Cons)106/2014-6707/F&E dated 10.04.2014, and No.12086/F&E dated 03.07.2014 on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change under section 2 of Forest(Conservation) Act, 1980.

After due consideration of the proposal of the State Government and on the basis of recommendation of State Advisory Group, the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change hereby conveys 'in-principle' approval for diversion of 12.63 ha of forest land for laying of slurry pipeline for disposal of ash from Captive Power Plant (CPP) of National Aluminium Company Ltd. (NALCO) to Bharatpur South Coal Block of Mahanadi Coalfields Ltd. (MCL) and to bring back decanted water from the mines after treatment to CPP for re-use, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions.

- 1. Legal status of forest land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged.
- 2. The State Govt. shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) of forest area proposed to be diverted under this proposal from the user agency at the rates as per the Orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide its letter No. 5-3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009 in this regard.
- At the time of payment of the Net Present Value (NPV) at the then prevailing rate, the user agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
- 4. Compensatory afforestation over the degraded forest land twice in extent to the forest land being diverted (i.e. 2 x 12.63 = 25.26 ha) shall be raised and maintained by the State Forest Department at the cost of the user agency.
- 5. The user agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation, at the current wage rate, to the State Forest Department. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.

- The funds realized from the user agency shall be transferred to the ad-hoc CAMPA
 in the concerned saving bank account in Union Bank of India, Sunder Nagar
 Branch, New Delhi.
- 7. Where possible and technically feasible, the user agency shall undertake afforestation along the pipeline within the area diverted under this approval, in consultation with the State Forest Department at the project cost.
- 8. The user agency shall obtain Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if required.
- 9. No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- 10. The user agency shall provide alternate fuel to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.
- 11. The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, forward and back bearing and distance from pillar to pillar.
- 12. The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal and under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person.
- 13. The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change.
- 14. The user agency shall ensure that because of this project, no damage is caused to the flora and fauna available in the area.
- 15. Felling of trees on the forest land being diverted shall be reduced to the bare minimum and the trees should be felled under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.
- 16. (NALCO) to Bharatpur South Coal Block of Mahanadi Coalfields Ltd. (MCL) and to bring back decanted water from the mines after treatment to CPP for re-use.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Govt. letter No. 10F(Cons)106/2014-6707/F&E dated 10.04.2014, and No.12086/F&E dated 03.07.2014, wherein prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change for diversion of 12.63 ha of forest land for laying of slurry pipeline for disposal of ash from Captive Power Plant (CPP) of National Aluminium Company Ltd. (NALCO) to Bharatpur South Coal Block of Mahanadi Coalfields Ltd. (MCL) and to bring back decanted water from the mines after treatment to CPP for re-use, was sought in accordance with Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. After due consideration of the proposal by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change and on the basis of decision of State Advisory Group held on 29.05.2014, the in-principle approval for diversion of the said forest land was accorded by Ministry vide this office letter of even number dated 05.09.2014, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions. The State Government has furnished compliance report in respect of the conditions stipulated in the in-principle approval and has requested to grant final approval of the proposal.

- In this connection, I am directed to say that on the basis of the compliance report furnished 2. by the State Government of Odisha vide their letter No.10F(Cons)106/2014-205/F&E dated 04.01.2016 No.10F(Cons)90/2016-16174/F&E dated 30.08.2016, No.24132/F&E dated 24.12.2016 and OSD, Adhoc CAMPA, New Delhi letter No.1-26/2013-CAMPA dated 13.01.2016, approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change is hereby granted under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 12.63 ha of forest land for laying of slurry pipeline for disposal of ash from Captive Power Plant (CPP) of National Aluminium Company Ltd. (NALCO) to Bharatpur South Coal Block of Mahanadi Coalfields Ltd. (MCL) and to bring back decanted water from the mines after treatment to CPP for re-use, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-
 - Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged. i)
 - Additional amount of NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization ii) of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, shall be charged by State Govt. from the user agency. An undertaking from the user agency shall be obtained in this regard.
 - Compensatory afforestation over the degraded forest land twice in extent to the forest land iii) diverted (i.e. 2 x 12.63 = 25.26 ha or 26 ha) shall be raised and maintained by the State Forest Department at the cost of the user agency.

- For Compensatory afforestation area minimum 26000 plants have to be planted (26 ha 1000) and for doing that they need to cover more area under compensatory afforestation instead of 26 ha. The State Govt. shall identify degraded forest land (DFL) within its administrative control and submit the location of area and shape file with possible number of plants to be planted in the proposed degraded forest land.
 - v) Wherever possible and technically feasible, the user agency shall undertake afforestation along the pipeline within the area diverted under this approval, in consultation with the State-Forest Department at the project cost.
 - vi) The user agency shall obtain Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, if required.
 - vii) The user agency shall comply with the conditions stipulated by State Govt. vide letter No.10(Cons)106/2014-6707/F&E dated 10.04.2014.
 - viii) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
 - ix) The user agency shall provide alternate fuel to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.
 - x) The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, forward and back bearing and distance from pillar to pillar.

 - xvii) The user agency shall submit the annual report on compliance to the conditions stipulated in the approval to the State Govt. and the concerned Regional Office of this Ministry.
 - xviii) The user agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.

- xix) In case of non-compliance of any of the above conditions, the State Govt. shall report to this office as per procedure laid down in the clause 1.9 of guidelines issued under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
- 3. As has been mentioned at Para-2 of the Stage-II approval, this approval for diversion of forest land is subject to the fulfillment of stipulated conditions mentioned in this approval letter. Therefore, in the event of non-compliance of any of the conditions laid out in this approval letter, the Eastern Regional Office of MoEFCC may withdraw the said approval for diversion of the forest land and stop the non-forest activity being carried out in the forest land besides initiating the legal action as per provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
