WHEREAS,M/s Tata Steel Ltd, 2B, Fortune Tower, Chandrasekharpur, Bhubaneswar-23 had applied for diversion of 9.037ha. of forest land for construction of Railwayline from Jakhpura Railway Station to Steel Plant site of M/s Tata Steel Ltd. at Kalinga Nagar in Jajpur district, Odisha by them..

And whereas, the Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change (hereinafter referred to as MoEF&CC), Government of India, Eastern Regional Office had accorded 'inprinciple' approval for diversion of 9.037ha. of forest land for construction of Railwayline from Jakhpura Railway Station to Steel Plant site of M/s Tata Steel Ltd. at Kalinga Nagar in Jajpur district, Odisha vide its letter No.5-ORC202/2014-BHU dt. 11.8.2014 (ANNEXURE-1).

And whereas, the MoEF&CC, Government of India, Eastern Regional Office in consideration of the compliance of the conditions of the 'in-principle' approval, has accorded final approval for diversion of said 9.037ha. of forest land for construction of Railwayline from Jakhpura Railway Station to Steel Plant site of M/s Tata Steel Ltd. at Kalinga Nagar in Jajpur district, Odisha vide its letter No. 5-ORC202/2014-BHU dt. 12.7.2018(Annexure-2) under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. Detailed land schedule of 9.037ha. of diverted forest land duly authenticated by Tahasildar, Danagadi is appended herewith as Annexure-3.

Now therefore, the Government of Odisha, do hereby allow diversion of above mentioned 9.037ha. forest land in Cuttack Forest Division of Danagadi Tahasil of Jajpur district in favour of M/s Tata Steel Ltd as per approved land use pattern subject to fulfillment of the conditions of final forest clearance order as stipulated by the MoEF&CC, Government of India, Eastern Regional Office.

The Collector of Jajpur is hereby authorized to handover the forest land coming within his jurisdiction, as has been finally diverted following due procedure of law. Before handing over the diverted forest land to the user agency, it shall be ensured that Net Present

Value for forest land for this project as well as for any other projects, belonging to same user agency, is deposited, in full, at applicable rates.

The Divisional Forest Officer of Cuttack Forest Division is also directed to monitor compliance to the conditions stipulated for such diversion in the respective forest/Wildlife clearance order and to report violations, if any, to the Nodal Officer, O/O Pr. CCF, Odisha and to the Forest & Environment Department.

Execution of project activities will be subject to availability of all other statutory clearances required under relevant Act/Rules for this infrastructure project, deposit of requisite funds and compliance of Court's order, if any.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Govt. letter No.10F(Cons)99/2014-7614/F&E dated 26.04.2014, No.8049/F&E dated 01.05.2014 and No.9404/F&E dated 22.05.2014 on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

After due consideration of the proposal of the State Government and on the basis of recommendation of State Advisory Group, the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change hereby conveys 'in-principle' approval for diversion of 9.037 ha of forest land for construction of Railway line from Jakhpura Railway Station to Steel Plant Site of M/s Tata Steel Ltd. at Kalinga Nagar in Jajpur district of Odisha, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions.

- 1. Legal status of forest land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged.
- 2. The State Govt. shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) of forest area proposed to be diverted under this proposal from the user agency at the rates as per the Orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide its letter No. 5-3/2007-FC dated 05.02.2009 in this regard.
- 3. Additional amount of NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, shall be charged by the State Govt. from the user agency. An undertaking from the user agency shall be obtained in this regard.
- Compensatory Afforestation shall be raised over 9.037 ha of non-forest land 4.(a)identified by the State Govt. in Plot No.6(P), Khata No.876AAA, Kisam Pahad of village Chandital under Darpan Tehsil of Jajpur at the cost of the user agencyby State Forest Department. The user agency shall transfer the cost of compensatory afforestation and its maintenance for 10 years (revised as on the date to incorporate the existing wage structure) to the Forest Department.
 - The non-forest land identified for raising compensatory afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in favour of the State Forest Department before issue of Stage-II approval.

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- 4. The State Government shall deposit Net Present Value and all other funds with the Ad-hoc Body of Compensatory Afforestation Fund Management and Planning Authority (CAMPA), in SB Account No.SB01025222 of Corporation Bank, CGO Complex, Phase-1, Lodhi Road, New Delhi 110 003 (RTGS/IFSC No.CORP0000371) or in SB Account No.344902010105428 of Union Bank of India, Sunder Nagar, New Delhi 110 003 (RTGS/IFSC No.UBIN0534498) by RTGS/NEFT modes, as per the instruction communicated vide letter No.12-2/2010-CAMPA dated 13.05.2011 and dated 24.06.2011.
- 5. State Govt. shall upload the compensatory levies demanded and received from the user agency in the Ministry website before Stage-II approval.
- 6. The boundary of the forest land proposed to be diverted shall be demarcated on the ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, DGPS coordinates, forward and back bearing and distance from adjoining pillars etc. The distance between any two pillars shall be kept at about 50 mtr and each pillar should be clearly visible from pillars on both sides.
- 7. The State Forest Department/UA shall submit the surveyed sketch 9.037 ha of non-forest land identified by the State Govt. in Plot No.6(P), Khata No.876AAA, Kisam Pahad of village Chandital under Darpan Tehsil of Jajpur as proposed for CA, giving the forward and backward bearing of each demarcation pillar and distance between them. The State Forest Department/User Agency shall submit the DGPS reading of each demarcated pillar giving the latitude and the longitude.
- 8. The site specific wildlife conservation plan as proposed by the State Govt. shall be implemented with the approval of CWLW, Odisha at project cost.
- 9. Felling of trees on the forest land being diverted shall be felled in a phased manner under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.
- 10. Adequate and effective soil and water conservation measures shall be implemented by the User Agency at project cost to prevent any further land degradation in the forest land. The Forest Department shall be consulted while implementing the above scheme.
- 11. The rocks/morum excavated from work site should be utilized by the Railways/State government for various construction purposes etc.
- 12. The quarrying site, if any, shall be fully reclaimed biologically by the User Agency at project cost in consultation with Forest Department.
- 13. The designing of culverts/bridges, if any, over the natural streams/ rivers/canals should be done in such a manner that it does not hamper the natural course of water, does not give rise to water-logging, and also does not hamper movement of wild animals.
- 14. No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work.
- 15. No labour camp shall be allowed in the forest area.
- 16. The user agency shall provide fuelwood, preferably alternate fuel, to labourers working at the site to avoid damage/tree felling.
- 17. The user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.

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- 18. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change.
- 19. The layout plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change.
- 20. Any other conditions that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, which shall be complied by the user agency.
- 21. The user agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.

After receipt of the report on compliance to the conditions stipulated above, from the State Government of Odisha, final/Stage-II approval for diversion of the said forest land under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 will be issued by this Ministry. Transfer of forest land to user agency should not be effected by the State Government of Odisha till final/Stage-II approval for its diversion is issued by the Ministry of Environment & Forests.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Govt. letter No. 10F(Cons)99/2014-7614/F&E dated 26.04.2014, No.8049/F&E dated 01.05.2014 and No.9404/F&E dated 22.05.2014, wherein prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change for diversion of 9.037 ha of forest land for construction of Railway line from Jakhpura Railway Station to Steel Plant Site of M/s Tata Steel Ltd. at Kalinga Nagar in Jajpur district of Odisha, was sought in accordance with Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. After due consideration of the proposal by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change and on the basis of recommendation of State Advisory Group meeting held on 25.05.2014, the in-principle approval for diversion of the said forest land was accorded by Ministry vide this office letter of even number dated 11.08.2014, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions. The State Government has furnished compliance report in respect of the conditions stipulated in the in-principle approval and has requested to grant final approval of the proposal.

- 2. In this connection, I am directed to say that on the basis of the compliance report furnished by the Addl. PCCF & Nodal Officer (FCA), Odisha vide their letter No.24809/9F(MG)-375/2012 dated 21.11.2017 and Ad-hoc CAMPA, New Delhi letter No.1-26/2014-CAMPA dated 20.06.2018, *Stage-II/final* approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change is hereby granted under Section 2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 9.037 ha of forest land for construction of Railway line from Jakhpura Railway Station to Steel Plant Site of M/s Tata Steel Ltd. at Kalinga Nagar in Jajpur district of Odisha, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:
 - i) Legal status of the diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.
 - ii) Additional amount of NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, shall be charged by State Govt. from the user agency.
 - iii) Compensatory Afforestation shall be raised over 9.037 ha of non-forest land identified by the State Govt. in Plot No.6(P), Khata No.876AAA, Kisam Pahad of village Chandital under Darpan Tehsil of Jajpur district against the area of forest land being diverted within a period of three years with effect from the date of issue of Stage-II clearance and maintained thereafter in accordance with the approved Plan in consultation with the State Forest Department at the cost of user agency. The C.A. plots have to be demarcated with GPS readings.

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- The non-forest land which has been transferred and mutated in favour of the State For, at Department for the purpose of compensatory afforestation shall be declared as Reserved Forest under Section-4 or Protected Forest under Section-29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927 or under the relevant Section (s) of the local Forest Act. The Nodal Officer must report compliance within a period of 6 months from the date of grant of final approval and send a copy of the original notification declaring the non-forest land under Section-4 or Section-29 of the Indian Forest Act, 1927, or under the relevant section of the local Forest Act as the case may be to this Ministry for information and record.
- v) State Govt./Forest Deptt. will focus on creation of water bodies by impounding nullahs and/or excavations at appropriate sites under the soil & moisture conservation works and shall ensure plantation of local tree & shrub and grass species and shall intimate the Eastern Regional Office, Bhubaneswar for record and monitoring.
- vi) The user agency will abide by the applicable recommendations of the State Government.
- vii) The boundary of the forest land being diverted shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, DGPS coordinates, forward and back bearing and distance from pillar to pillar.
- viii) The site specific wildlife conservation plan as proposed by the State Govt. shall be implemented with the approval of CWLW, Odisha at project cost.
- ix) Adequate and effective soil and water conservation measures shall be implemented by the User Agency at project cost to prevent any further land degradation in the forest land. The Forest Department shall be consulted while implementing the above scheme.
- x) The rocks/morum excavated from work site should be utilized by the Railways/State government for various other construction purposes etc.
- xi) The quarrying site, if any, shall be fully reclaimed biologically by the User Agency at project cost in consultation with Forest Department.
- xii) The designing of culverts/bridges, if any, over the natural streams/ rivers/canals should be done in such a manner that it does not hamper the natural course of water, does not give rise to water-logging, and also does not hamper movement of wild animals.
- xiii) No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work.
- xiv) No labour camp shall be allowed in the forest area.
- xv) The user agency shall provide alternate fuel preferably LPG to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the adjacent forest areas.
- xvi) The user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.
- xvii) The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change.



- xviii) The layout plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change.
- xix) The user agency shall submit annual self monitoring report on compliance of stipulated conditions to the Nodal Officer (FCA) of the State and Eastern Regional Office of this Ministry.
- Any other conditions that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, which shall be complied by the user agency.
- xxi) The user agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, Hon'ble Court Order (s) and National Green Tribunal Order (s) pertaining to this projects, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
- xxii) In case of non-compliance of any of the above conditions, the State Govt. shall report to this office as per procedure laid down in the clause 1.9 of guidelines issued under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
- 3. As has been mentioned at Para-2 of the Stage-II approval, this approval for diversion of forest land is subject to the fulfillment of stipulated conditions mentioned in this approval letter. Therefore, in the event of non-compliance of any of the conditions laid out in this approval letter, the Eastern Regional Office of MoEFCC may withdraw the said approval for diversion of the forest land and stop the non-forest activity being carried out in the forest land besides initiating the legal action as per provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

Joint verification report on the site visit of 9.037 ha or 22.330 Acres forest land to be diverted for construction of Railway corridor from Jakhapura Railway station to steel plant site of M/s. Tata Steel at Kalinganagar.

Date of site visit: 29.05.2013

The joint field verification has been done along with the Tahasildar, Danagadi, the representatives of user agency (Tata Steel Ltd) and Revenue Inspector, Mantira circle on 29.05.2013 and the findings are as follows:

01. The forest kisam land of 9.037 ha or 22.33 Acres of village Rabana proposed for diversion for non-forestry use has been properly demarcated in the field with concrete pillars.
