10F (Cons) 34/2020

Whereas Forest block Kusunpur II Reserve Forest under the provisions of section 9 of the Mayurbhanj Forest Act has been notified by Government of Maharaja of Mayurbhanj vide Notification No.F/G/9/2823 dtd.21/06/1945 indicating an area of 108 Ac in Karanjia Forest Range of Karanjia Forest Division, as per Annexure-I.

And whereas, the Government of Odisha in the Forest & Environment Department have notified a "Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for Geo-referencing of Forest Block boundary through DGPS Survey" in the Odisha Gazette vide Notification No.22572400112016-10F(Cons) 77/2016/14097/F&E dtd.04.07.2017, for preparation of such geo-referenced forest maps in pursuance of the directives of Hon'ble Supreme Court in their Order dtd.6.7.2011 (in IA Nos. 1868, 2091, 2225-2227, 2380, 2568 and 2937 in Writ Petition (C) No. 202 of 1995 – Lafarge matter).

And whereas, the Government of Odisha have appointed all Tehsildars in their respective Tehsil jurisdiction in the respective Districts as Forest Settlement Officer (FSO) vide Notification No.10F(TR)38/2020/7767/F&E Dated 21/05/2020.

And whereas, the Forest Revenue Joint Verification Committee has jointly verified and confirmed the boundary pillar positions as per report in Annexure-II.

And whereas, the Forest Settlement Officer has certified 'No Change' in the boundary extent of Kusunpur II Reserve Forest post 25th October 1980. The DGPS survey boundary coordinates have been verified by ORSAC and certified by the Forest Settlement Officer. The computed area (UTM Zone 45 N projection and WGS 84 datum) of the Kusunpur II Reserve Forest is 38.24 Ha or 94.49 Ac. The change in area may be due to old survey techniques and boundary in some parts might have undergone change because of village settlements.

Therefore, it has been decided to supplement the existing notification of the Kusunpur II Reserve Forest with the above mentioned FSO certified DGPS surveyed Forest block map as per Annexure-III and the statement of geo-coordinates of the forest block boundary pillar positions as per Annexure-IV, which shall be treated as the precise boundary description of the, Kusunpur II Reserve Forest and shall form an integral part of the original notification in place of any other form of boundary description notified earlier.

There shall be no change to the admitted rights in the original notification.

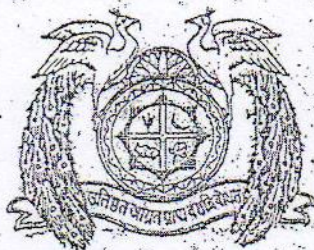

Amendments to the Paper Control (Economy)

Order 1945

The 6th June, 1945.

No. WM/1-2/2636.—In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-rule (2) of rule 70 of the Defence of Mayurbhanj Rules, the Government of the

Maharaja of Mayurbhanj is pleased to direct that the following further amendments shall be made in the Paper Control (Economy) Order, 1945, namely:—

1. In the said Order, —

(i) in sub-clause (i) of clause 2 for the words "on both sides" wherever they occur, the words "on either side" shall be substituted;

(2) in sub-clause (ii) of clause 3 after the word "almanac" the brackets and words "(not being a religious almanac)" shall be inserted;

(3) in sub-clause (i) (a) of clause 5, (i) for the words "print or make or" the words "in any calendar month" shall be substituted, and (ii) after the word "business" the words "the aggregate weight of which exceeds 25 lbs." shall be inserted;

(4) for sub-clause (12) clause 5, the following sub-clause shall be substituted namely:—

"(2) Nothing in the sub-clause [1] shall apply to the distribution gratuitously or otherwise of a

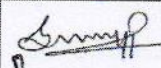
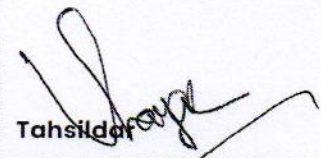
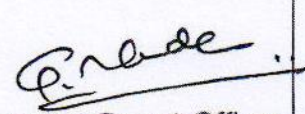
Joint Verification of the boundary of **Kusunpur-II Reserve Forest** Block was carried out during 29-01-2020 to 29-01-2020. Existing pillar position recorded through GPS were plotted and compared against geo-referenced cadastral maps of adjoining villages. The verified forest boundary map is enclosed at Plate-1. Findings of the verification w.r.t. revenue cadastral is given below:

- Name of notified forest block: Kusunpur-II Reserve Forest
- Notification no. & date: F/G/9/2823 Dt. 21-06-1945
- Area as per notification: 108 Ac/43.20 Ha.
- Existing no. of boundary demarcations in conformity with adjoining village boundary: 11 nos. (Annexure -1)
- New boundary demarcations in conformity with adjoining village boundary: 16 nos. (Annexure -2)
- GPS area of verified boundary: 38.22 ha.
- GPS perimeter of verified boundary: 4.14 km

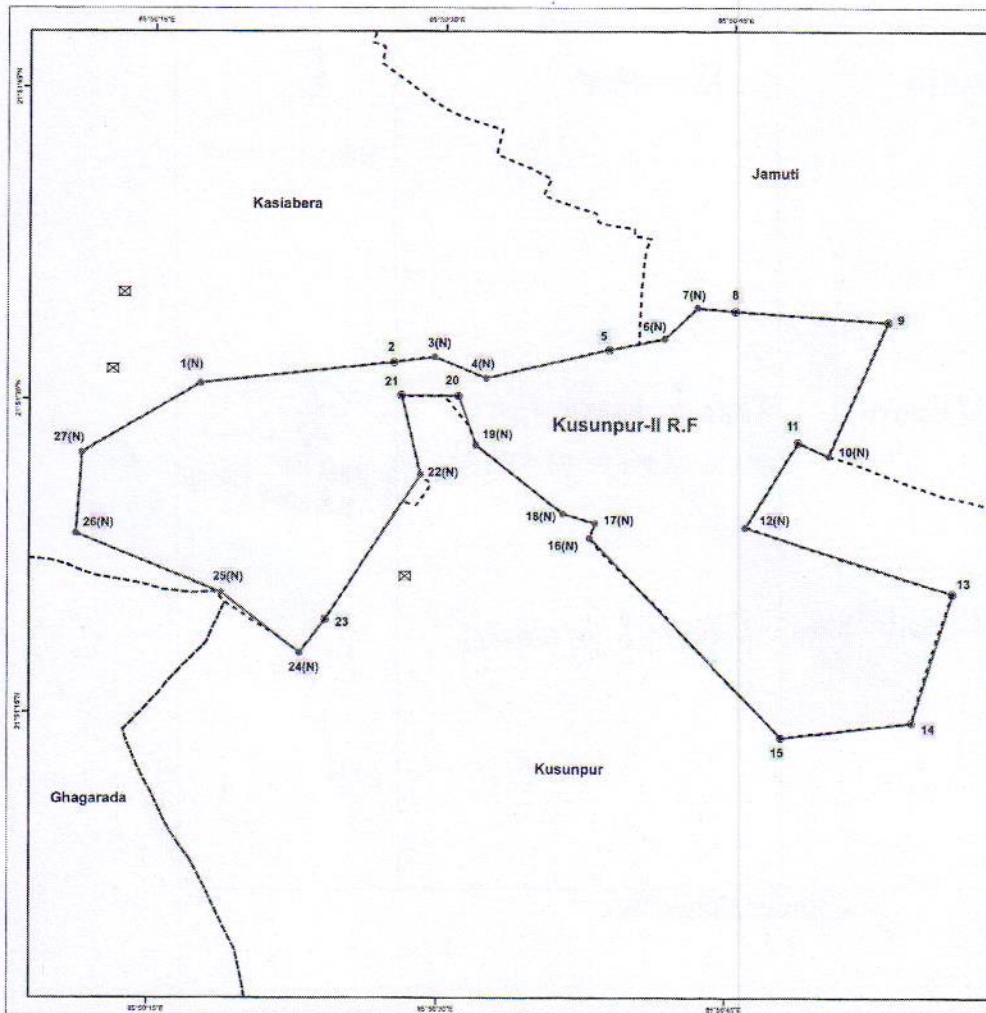
Observations:

Notification is available (Boundary & Chainage bearing is not available) and Traverse map is enclosed at Appendix-1 & Appendix-2. The verified boundary approximately matching with MMV, and NFA more than CMA. Forest boundary demarcations pillars are in conformity with CMA, Existing pillars and HRSI. Change in area may be due to projection system and survey techniques. Since all peripheral settlements have occurred prior to 1980. There is no implication under FC Act.

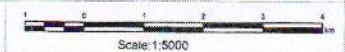

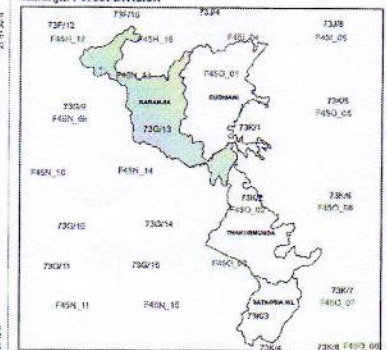

Karanja Forest Division Index Map

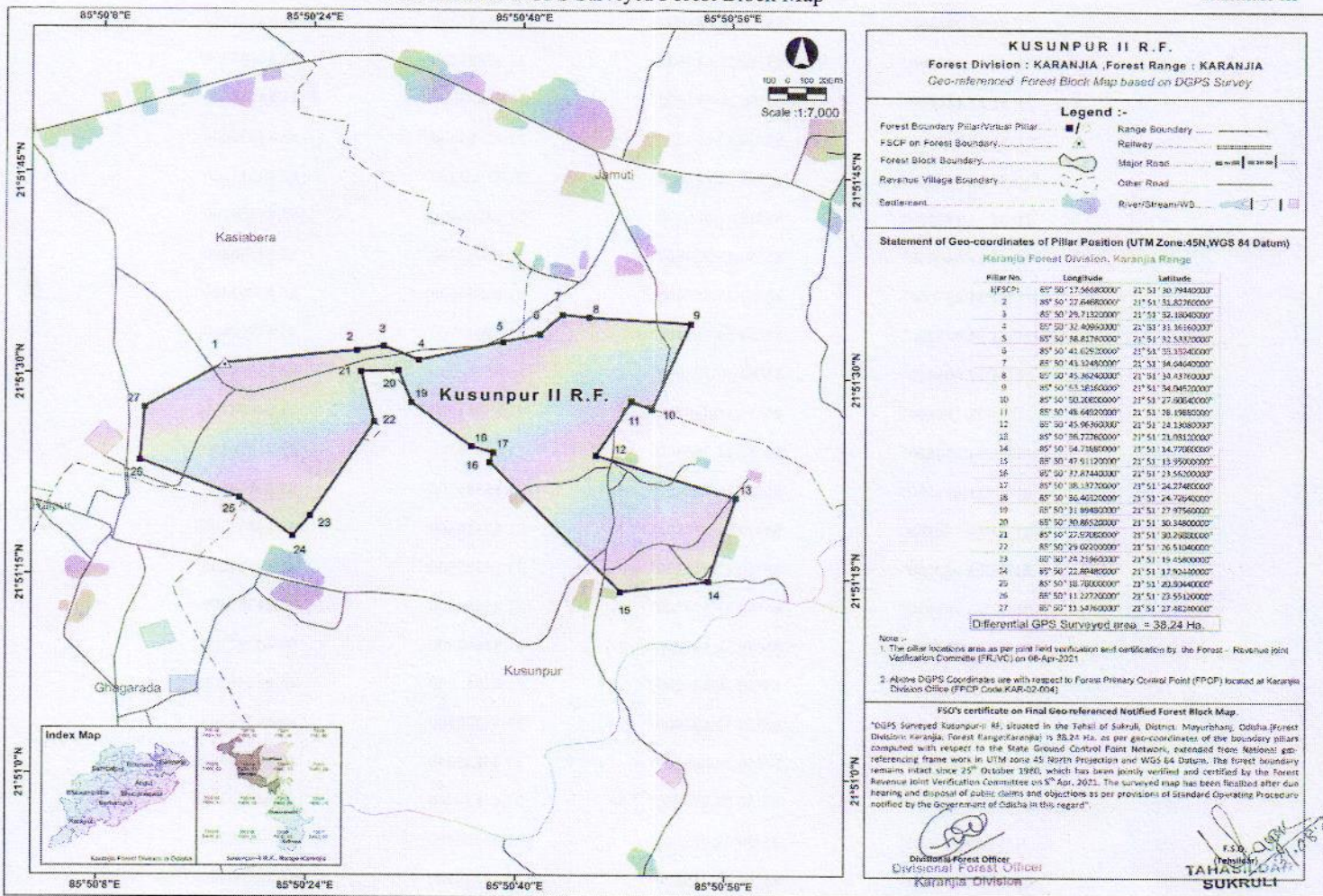
