Sub: Stage-II/Final approval for non-forestry use of 3.003 ha of forest land for improvement of road (RCPLWE-Phase-II) Narigaon-Gillaguntha-Betabadi from Chainage 0.000 Km to 5.087 Km under Koraput Forest Division in Koraput District by Executive Engineer, Koraput (R&B) Division.

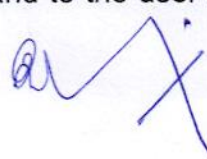
WHEREAS, the Executive Engineer (R&B) Division, Koraput, Odisha-764020 had applied for diversion of 3.003 ha of Forest land for improvement or road (RCPLWE-Phase-II) to Narigaon-Gillaguntha-Betabadi from Chainage 0/000 Km to 5/087 Km under Koraput Forest Division in Koraput District.

And whereas, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India, Regional Office, Bhubaneswar had accorded '**Stage-I/in-principle**' approval for diversion of 3.003 ha of forest land for improvement or road (RCPLWE-Phase-II) Narigaon-Gillaguntha-Betabadi from Chainage 0.000 Km to 5.087 Km under Koraput Forest Division in Koraput District by Executive Engineer, Koraput (R&B) Division, subject to the fulfilment of the conditions as laid down therein vide Letter No.5-ORB586/2023-BHU dtd.31.07.2023 (**Annexure-I**).

And whereas, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, Government of India, Regional Office, Bhubaneswar in consideration of the compliance of the conditions of the 'Stage-I/in-principle' approval, have granted "**Stage-II/ final**" approval under Section-2 (1) (ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 for non-forestry use of 3.003 ha of forest land for improvement or road (RCPLWE-Phase-II) Narigaon-Gillaguntha-Betabadi from Chainage 0.000 Km to 5.087 Km under Koraput Forest Division in Koraput District by Executive Engineer, Koraput (R&B) Division, subject to the fulfilment of the conditions as stipulated therein vide Letter No.5-ORB586/2023-BHU/163 dtd.10.03.2026 (**Annexure-II**).

Now, therefore, the Government of Odisha, do hereby allow non-forestry use of 3.003 ha of forest land for improvement or road (RCPLWE-Phase-II) Narigaon-Gillaguntha-Betabadi from Chainage 0.000 Km to 5.087 Km under Koraput Forest Division in Koraput District by Executive Engineer, Koraput (R&B) Division, as per approved land schedule.

The Collector, Koraput & Divisional Forest Officer, Koraput Forest Division, as the case may be are hereby authorized to handover the forest land coming within their jurisdiction, as has been finally diverted after necessary compliance following due procedure of law. Before handing over the diverted forest land to the user agency, it shall



be ensured that Net Present Value of the forest land for this project for which approval has been obtained shall be deposited in full, at applicable rates.

The Divisional Forest Officer, Koraput Forest Division is also directed to monitor compliance to the conditions stipulated for such diversion in the respective forest/ wildlife clearance order and to report violations, if any, to the Nodal Officer, O/o Principal Chief Conservator Forests & HoFF, Odisha and to the Forest, Environment & Climate Change Department.

Execution of project activities will be subject to availability of all other statutory clearances required under relevant Acts/ Rules for this project, deposit of requisite funds and compliance of Court's order, if any.

The user agency is asked to take following actions immediately as per orders of Hon'ble National Green Tribunal dtd.07.11.2012 in Appeal No.07/2012 communicated by the MoEF, Government of India vide their letter F. No.7-23/2012-FC dtd.24.07.2013.

- i. ***They shall publish the entire forest clearance granted in verbatim along with conditions and safeguards imposed by the Central Government in Stage-I/II forest clearance in two widely circulated daily newspapers, one in vernacular***

language and the other in English language so as to make people aware of the permission granted to the Project for use of forest land for non-forest purposes.

- ii. *They shall submit the copies of forest clearance orders granted by the Central Government/State Government to the Heads of local bodies, Panchayats and Municipal bodies along with the relevant offices of the State Government, who in turn, shall display the same for 30 days from date of receipt.*
- iii. *Detailed action taken in compliance to the above order of State Government shall be intimated to the DFO, Koraput Forest Division/ RCCF, Koraput Circle/ PCCF & HoFF, Odisha/ Forest, Environment & Climate Change Department for reference.*

Besides the above, the user agency is also asked to deposit Net Present Value of forest land for this project in full, if not deposited yet, at applicable rates. R equisite funds due for deposit by the user agency on account of this project shall also be deposited under appropriate head.

The user agency shall furnish compliances to the conditions prescribed in the forest/wildlife clearance order to the Divisional Forest Officer, Koraput Forest Division in every quarter, for the purpose of monitoring by him.

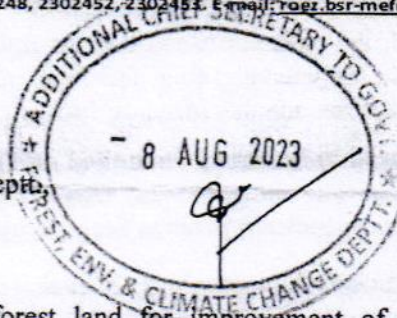

Sub:- Diversion of 3.003 ha of forest land for improvement of road (RCPLWE-Phase-II) Narigaon-Gillaguntha-Betabadi from Chainage 0.000 Km to 5.087 Km under Koraput Forest Division in Koraput District by Executive Engineer, Koraput (R&B) Division.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Govt. letter No.FE-DIV-FLD-0062-2023-14410/FE&CC dated 11.07.2023 on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change under section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.

2. After due consideration of the proposal of the State Government, the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change hereby conveys 'Stage-I/in-principle' approval for diversion of Diversion of 3.003 ha of forest land for improvement of road (RCPLWE-Phase-II) Narigaon-Gillaguntha-Betabadi from Chainage 0.000 Km to 5.087 Km under Koraput Forest Division in Koraput District by Executive Engineer, Koraput (R&B) Division, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions.

A: Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land by the State Forest Department.

- The user agency shall transfer online, the Net Present Value (NPV) of 3.003 Ha forest land being diverted under this proposal, as per the Orders of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 28.03.2008, 24.04.2008 and 09.05.2008 in Writ Petition (Civil) No.202/1995 and the guidelines issued by this Ministry vide its letter No.5-3/2011-FC (Vol-I) dated 06.01.2022, 19.01.2022 & 22.03.2022. The requisite funds shall be transferred through online portal in CAMPA account of the State concerned.
- The identified non-forest land of 4.00 Ha for raising compensatory afforestation shall be transferred and mutated in the name of Forest Department and notified as RF/PF prior to Stage-II approval.
- The land identified for the purpose of Compensatory Afforestation/Addl. C.A. shall be clearly depicted on a Survey of India Topo sheet of 1 : 50,000 scale.
- The KML files of the area to be diverted and the CA areas shall be uploaded on the e-Green watch portal with all requisite details before issuing working permission towards linear projects or submitting compliance report for seeking Stage-II approval, as the case may be.
- The user agency shall transfer the cost of raising and maintaining the compensatory afforestation at the current wage rate in consultation with State Forest Department in the account of CAMPA of the concerned State through online portal. The Scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.
- All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/ deposited in CAMPA account only through e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>). Amount deposited through other mode will not be accepted as compliance of the Stage-I clearance.

- vii) The compliance report of the Stage-I approval shall be uploaded on e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>).
- viii) The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector.
- ix) The boundary of the proposed forest land for diversion, shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates.

B: Conditions which need to be strictly complied on field after handing over of forest land to the user agency by the State Forest Department but the compliance in form of undertaking shall be submitted prior to Stage-II approval.

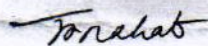
- i) Legal status of forest land proposed for diversion shall remain unchanged.
- ii) Compensatory afforestation shall be raised over 4.00 Ha of non-forest land identified in Plot No.01, Khata No.76 of Kissam-Phada of Village Gumaguda under Nandapur Tahasil of Koraput District under Koraput Forest Division within one year from the date of Stage-II Clearance and maintained thereafter by the State Forest Department, at the cost of user agency. The species to be planted in the CA scheme shall be of native species of the area. At least 18 month old seedlings should be planted. Intensive monitoring of the plantation needs to be done and documented using Geo tagging so that the increase of canopy density and survival and growth of plantation can be evaluated at regular intervals.
- iii) At the time of payment of Net Present Value (NPV) at the then prevailing rate, the user agency shall furnish an undertaking to pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.
- iv) The user agency shall take up Avenue Plantation on either side of the alignment of the road at the project cost in consultation with the DFO. In this regard State Govt. shall adhere to the Ministry's letter No.7-12/2022-ROHQ dated 01.09.2022.
- v) The user agency shall explore the possibility of successful transplantation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.
- vi) The user agency shall use fly ash for the road construction and for filling up of void created due to soil borrows which will be followed by compaction and spreading of top soil over it as per Fly Ash Notification No. S.O. 254 (E) dated 25.01.2016.
- vii) The user agency shall submit an undertaking to ensure that flanks of roads should be filled by transported soil and not with soil dug from the side of the roads.
- viii) The designing of new culverts/bridges and redesigning the existing ones over the natural streams/ rivers/canals should be done in such a manner that it does not hamper the natural course of water, does not give rise to water-logging, so that it does not hamper movement of wild animals including fishes & amphibians migration.
- ix) Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Protected Areas/Forest Areas.
- x) The user agency shall obtain Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.
- xi) No labour camp shall be established on the forest land and the user agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.
- xii) No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work.
- xiii) The user agency while executing works, shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.

- xiv) The layout plan of the proposed forest land shall not be changed without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.
- xv) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal.
- xvi) The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without the prior approval of Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.
- xvii) No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused.
- xviii) The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area.
- xix) The user agency shall submit annual self monitoring report on compliance of stipulated conditions to the Nodal Officer (FCA) of the State and concerned Integrated Regional Office of this Ministry by the end of March every year.
- xx) Any other conditions that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, shall be complied by the user agency.
- xxi) The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT Order (s) & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
- xxii) Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in Para 1.21 of Chapter 1 of the Handbook of comprehensive guidelines of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 as issued by this Ministry's letter No.5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.

4. After receipt of the report on compliance to the conditions stipulated above, from the State Government of Odisha, final/Stage-II approval for diversion of the said forest land under Section 2 of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 will be issued by this Ministry. Transfer of forest land to user agency should not be effected by the State Government of Odisha till final/Stage-II approval for its diversion is issued by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.

5. "The State Govt. or a Senior Office not below the Rank of a Divisional Forest Officer, having jurisdiction over the forest land proposed to be diverted, duly authorized in this behalf by the State Govt. can pass an order for tree cutting and commencement of work of a linear project in forest land for a period of one year. Such order shall be passed only after full realization of funds for compensatory afforestation, Net Present Value (NPV), Wildlife conservation Plan, plantation of dwarf species of medicinal plants, and all other compensatory levies, [specified in the Stage-I (in-principle) approval] from the User Agency, and where ever applicable, transfer and mutation of non-forest/revenue forest land in favour of State Forest Department" as stipulated in Para 11.2 of Chapter-11 of Handbook of Guidelines issued under F.C. Act, 1980 vide Ministry's letter No.5-2/2017-FC dated 28.03.2019.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to State Govt. letter No.FE-DIV-FLD-0062-2023-14410/FE&CC dated 11.07.2023, wherein prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change for non-forestry use of 3.003 ha of forest land for improvement of road (RCPLWE-Phase-II) Narigaon-Gillaguntha-Betabadi from Chainage 0.000 Km to 5.087 Km under Koraput Forest Division in Koraput District by Executive Engineer, Koraput (R&B) Division, was sought in accordance with Section-2 (1)(ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980. After due consideration of the proposal by the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change, the **in-principle** approval for non-forestry use of the said forest land was accorded by Ministry vide this office letter of even number dated 31.07.2023, subject to fulfillment of certain conditions. The State Government has furnished the compliance report in respect of the conditions stipulated in the in-principle approval and has requested to grant final approval of the proposal.

2. In this connection, I am directed to say that on the basis of the compliance report furnished by the Addl. PCCF & Nodal Officer (FCA), Odisha vide their letter No.10692/9F(Road)-418/2021 dated 16.05.2025, No.22930 dated 15.11.2025 and submission of the compliance report by State Govt. in *Parivesh* web portal on 09.03.2026, **Stage-II/final** approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change is hereby granted under Section 2 (1)(ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 for non-forestry use of 3.003 ha of forest land for improvement of road (RCPLWE-Phase-II) Narigaon-Gillaguntha-Betabadi from Chainage 0.000 Km to 5.087 Km under Koraput Forest Division in Koraput District by Executive Engineer, Koraput (R&B) Division, subject to the fulfillment of the following conditions:-

1. The State Govt. shall ensure that the legal status of diverted forest land shall remain unchanged.
2. The State Govt. shall ensure that the user agency shall pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India.

3. The State Govt. shall ensure the compliance on FRA, 2006 as per Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules and guidelines issued from time to time before handing over of the diverted forest land to user agency.
4. The State Govt. shall ensure that the State Forest Department will raise compensatory afforestation over 4.00 Ha of non-forest land identified in Plot No.01, Khata No.76 of KISSAM-PHADA of Village Gumaguda under Nandapur Tahasil of Koraput District under Koraput Forest Division within two year from the date of Stage-II Clearance and maintained thereafter by the State Forest Department, at the cost of user agency. The species to be planted in the CA scheme shall be of native species of the area. At least 18 month old seedlings should be planted. Intensive monitoring of the plantation needs to be done and documented using Geo tagging so that the increase of canopy density and survival and growth of plantation can be evaluated at regular intervals.
5. The State Govt. shall ensure that the KML files of the area to be diverted and CA areas shall be uploaded on the e-Green watch portal with all requisite details before handing over of the diverted forest land to the user agency.
6. The State Govt. shall ensure that the boundary of the diverted forest land shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS co-ordinates.
7. The State Govt. shall ensure that the user agency shall take up Avenue Plantation on either side of the alignment of the road at the project cost in consultation with the DFO. In this regard State Govt. shall adhere to the Ministry's letter No.7-12/2022-ROHQ dated 01.09.2022.
8. The State Govt. shall ensure that the user agency shall explore the possibility of successful transplantation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.
9. The State Govt. shall ensure that the user agency shall use fly ash for the road construction and for filling up of void created due to soil borrows which will be followed by compaction and spreading of top soil over it as per Fly Ash Notification No. S.O. 254 (E) dated 25.01.2016.
10. The State Govt. and the User Agency shall ensure that flanks of roads should be filled by transported soil and not with soil dug from the side of the roads.
11. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that the designing of new culverts/bridges and redesigning the existing ones over the natural streams/ rivers/canals should be done in such a manner that it does not hamper the natural course of water, does not give rise to water-logging, so that it does not hamper movement of wild animals including fishes & amphibians migration.
12. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Protected Areas/Forest Areas.
13. The State Govt. and the User Agency shall ensure that overburden shall not be disposed beyond the designated road width. Muck generated from earth cuttings shall be fully utilized for filling works. Any excess muck shall be disposed strictly in accordance with a Muck Disposal Plan. No muck or debris shall be permitted to roll down hill slopes.

14. The State Govt. and the User Agency shall ensure that retaining walls, breast walls, and drainage structures shall be constructed at appropriate locations to ensure slope stability and prevent erosion along the alignment.
15. The State Govt. and the user agency shall ensure that the reclamation of quarry should be done under the supervision of the State Forest Department. The quarry shall be reclaimed and afforested completely before the project is closed.
16. The State Govt. shall ensure that no labour camp shall be established on the forest land and the user agency shall provide fuels preferably alternate fuels to the labourers and staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas.
17. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that no additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for any activity related to the project work
18. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that while executing works, the user agency shall not fell any tree or damage forest growth in the surrounding forest area in any manner.
19. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that earth or any material shall neither be brought from nor the debris resulting during construction be disposed of in the adjoining forest area by the user agency.
20. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure that the layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.
21. The State Govt. shall ensure that the forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the proposal and under no circumstances be transferred to any other user agency, department or person without prior approval of the Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change.
22. The State Govt. shall ensure that no damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused.
23. The State Govt. shall ensure that the DFO concerned will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in surrounding area.
24. The State Govt. shall ensure that any other conditions that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation, conservation and management of flora and fauna in the area, which shall be complied by the user agency.
25. The State Govt. and user agency shall ensure compliance to provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, NGT Order (s) & Hon'ble Court Order (s) pertaining to this project, if any, for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
26. Any other direction issued by the Ministry as a result of Hon'ble Supreme Court order will have bearing on this approval.
27. Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and action would be taken as prescribed in Para 1.16 of Consolidated Guidelines and Clarification issued under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules, 2023 vide Ministry's letter dated 29.12.2023
